

ENGLISH

This term we will be reading 'Stig of the Dump'. Pupils will re-write the first chapter of 'Stig of the Dump' as a diary account and write a narrative replacing the two main characters and changing the setting. Pupils will include a description of the setting and their own 'Stig' character.

MATHS

In maths this term pupils will be developing their understanding of place value for numbers up to 1000. Pupils will develop a deeper understanding of the magnitude of numbers and develop useful mental calculating skills such as rounding and place value addition and subtraction. They go on to apply this knowledge to solve problems.

Please continue to help by asking your child to tell you the time, read and interpret timetables and calculate time spans.

SCIENCE

In Science pupils explore Rocks and Fossils at the same time as their prehistoric studies. They will then extend their knowledge of animals including humans by studying the skeleton.

ART / DT

Pupils will explore shading to achieve a range of light and dark tones - black to white. Draw familiar things from different viewpoints. Use line, tone, shape and mark with care to represent things seen, imagined or remembered.

HISTORY

In History, pupils are developing their understanding of chronology and they start delving back into the prehistoric age of British history. They explore the difficulties of making sense of a world we have no written record of. They explore the lives of the very 1st Britons; the hunter gatherers, the farmers, the craftsmen and the artists.
