

## English

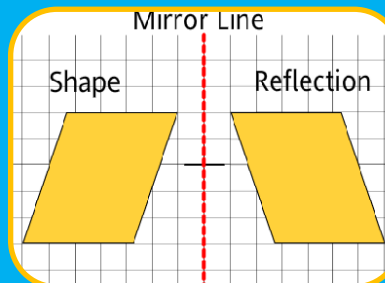

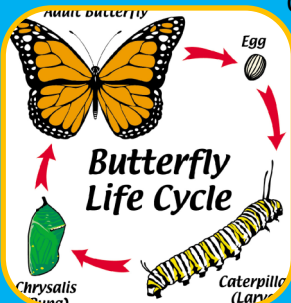

## Science

Our Science topic this term is Life Cycles!

## Art/DT

## Humanities
