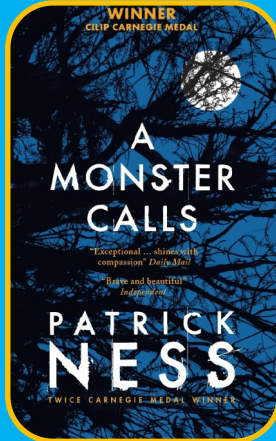


English

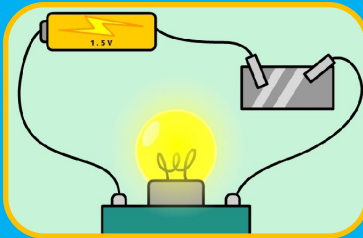
