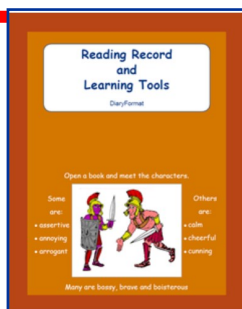
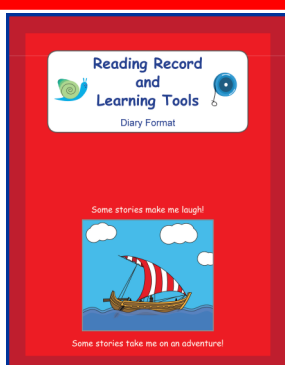
All pupils -5 Reads
