

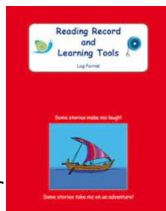
Year EYFS Termly Reminders:

Literacy

- Hear and say initial sounds.
- Recognise all set 1 sounds confidently.
- Develop listening and speaking skills in a range of contexts.
- Give meaning to marks they make. Understand that thoughts can be written down.
- Beginning to form letters with the correct formation.
- Start to blend known sounds to read simple regular words e.g. mum, dad.
- Begin to write CVC words and red words.
- To understand rhyme.

Maths

- Recognising numbers to 10
- Ordering numbers to 10
- Write numbers to 10
- Addition and subtraction - add and subtract two single digit numbers.
- Calendar - Days of the week and months of the year.
- Time - morning, afternoon and evening.
- Grouping and sharing.
- Reciting numbers to 20.
- One to one correspondence.

- Developing relationships with other children
- Maintaining focus for a period of time,
